I'm Madison Cochran, and I'm so excited to work with you guys! I'll be running SAT Prep Camps all summer.

### **A Little About Me**

I'm a rising sophomore at Georgia Tech majoring in Business Strategy and Innovation, and I have received Faculty Honors both semesters. I've been tutoring for three years. In high school, I was a student mentor through the C.L.A.W.S. program at Cambridge, and next semester, I'll be an RA on campus. I have two dogs and I love to crochet!

### **About the SAT**

The SAT is used by most colleges as a factor in admissions. Scoring within or above a college's desired SAT range means it is more likely your student will be accepted there. I received a 1540: 770 Math and 770 Evidence-Based Reading and Writing. The goal of the test is to measure readiness for college, and give colleges one easy number to look at when comparing students. The SAT has definitely undergone some transformations in the last several years. Currently, the SAT has two sections: Math and Evidence-Based Reading and Writing. In the Math section, College Board is mainly looking at your Algebra I knowledge, with a good bit of Geometry and basic Algebra 2 problems sprinkled in. In the Evidence-Based Reading and Writing section, they are looking at your reading comprehension skills and your grammar skills, and there will be a few questions about editing written works as well.

The great thing about the SAT is that *you already know most of the material you will be tested on*. It is the test that measures how well you learn about and prepare for the test.

### **Camp Details**

In my course, your student will:

- Take and review practice SAT exams
- Learn what types of problems are going to show up in each category of the exam and how to tackle them
- Specifically go over the "challenge" problems that will show up in each section of the exam and how to tackle them
- Review the math and reading content that will be tested on the exam
- Get one-on-one review
- Make a personalized SAT study schedule

**Each camp needs a minimum of 3 students to register for camp to occur. If at least 3 students do not register, the camp will be canceled for the week. There is space for 5 students in each camp.**

So, invite your friends! I want to keep the groups small to ensure your student gets personalized instruction. If more than 5 students have interest in going to camp on a specific week, I can usually add another camp session that week.

Each student will be given access to a Google Drive with resources for camp, as well as additional study materials and tips after registration. On the first day of camp, they will also be given a physical folder to help them keep track of everything. Please bring a notebook and a pencil or pen to camp for notes.

Camp will be held at my house, which is near Cambridge High School. The exact address will be sent to parents after registration.
